In case of fire, if safe to exit, we will use the bedroom door and stairs that lead to the front door. If unsafe or blocked by fire, we will exit by the nearest bedroom window using a portable ladder connected to the window (suggested).

Third Floor: There are _____ bedrooms on the third floor. Each bedroom has two exits-a door and a window. In case of fire, if safe to exit, we will use the bedroom door and stairs that lead to the front door. If unsafe or blocked by fire, we will exit by the nearest bedroom window using a portable ladder connected to the window (suggested).

All of the above mentioned exits are kept freely accessible at all times.

If the evacuation of the house is needed, all family members agree to meet OUT side where:

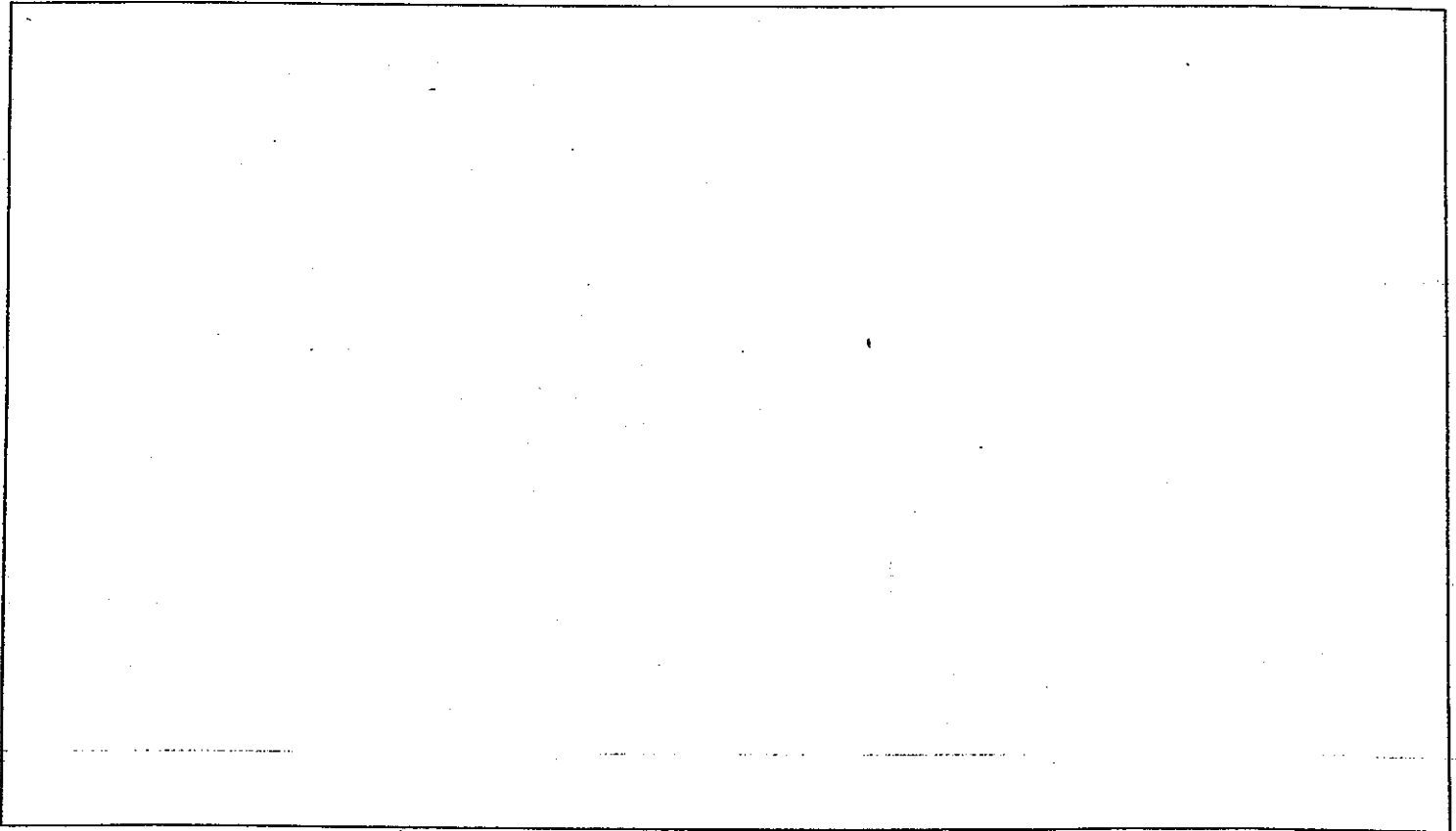

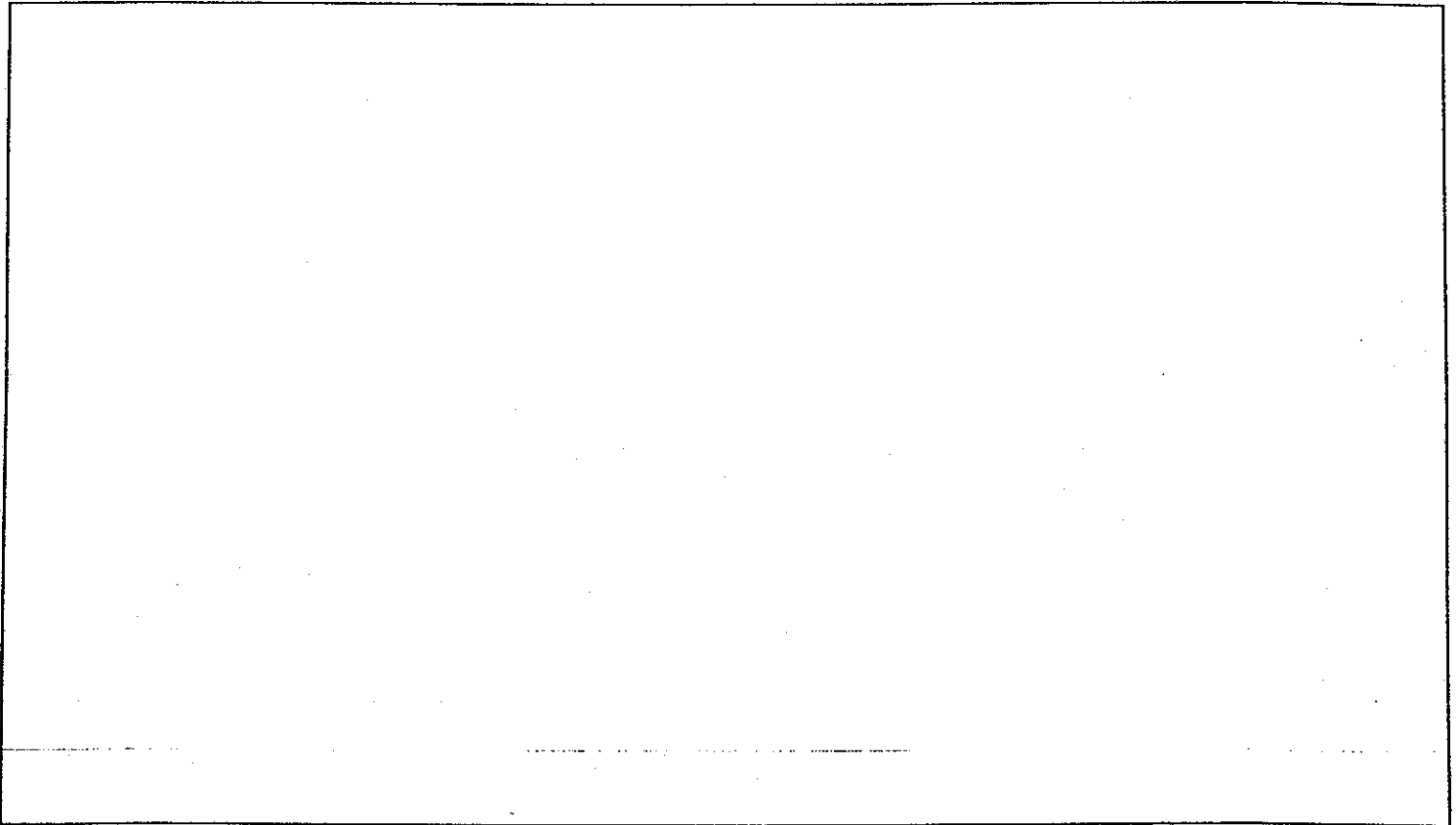

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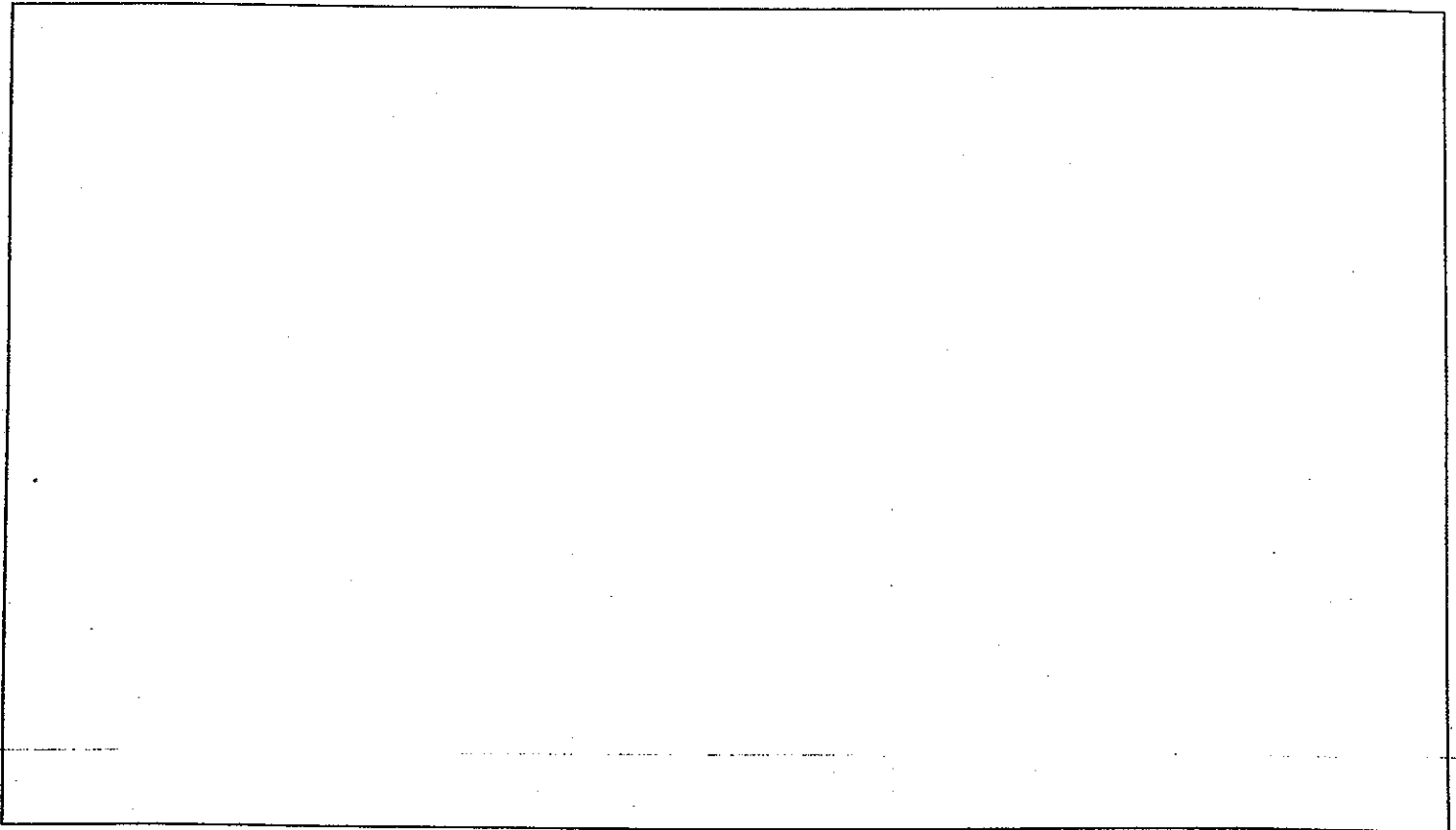
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
